

ITEMS NOT PERMITTED ON THE ADULT CARE UNIT

- Glass including perfume and make up bottles
- Mirrors
- Tweezers
- Nail clippers
- Scissors
- Weapons on any kind
- Belts
- Clothing ties (including hoodies)
- Bandanas/ "do" rags
- Sunglasses unless medically required
- Long heavy necklaces
- Dental floss
- Clothing with logos promoting sex, drugs, alcohol or racial slurs
- Q-tips
- Blankets and/or pillows
- Stuffed animals
- Excessive amounts of clothing
- Shoes with laces
- Toothpaste deodorant, shampoo and conditioner (these items will be provided)
- Visitors' purses, bags, etc.
- Belly shirts
- Halter tops
- Short shorts
- CD's
- Cell phones (patients or visitors)
- Tape recorders
- Wire hangers
- Headphones
- Ear buds
- Cameras
- Flowers
- Disposable Razors
- Personal computers/ iPads/tablets
- Any tobacco product, lighter, matches, electronic cigarettes/vapes
- Balloons
- No fast food or food in containers that have been opened
- Suitcases or large duffel bags

Please note that this is not an all-inclusive list and that some items not listed here may be prohibited as necessary.

Permitted Items

- Wedding rings (without protruding settings)
- Hairspray (used with supervision only)
- Prepackaged food items (unopened)
- Personal clothing excluding strings, ties & belts (3 changes of clothes only)
- Slippers - Your feet must be covered when you are out of your room.
- Eyeglasses
- Watches
- Decaffeinated beverages
- 1 Pair of pajamas
- Toothbrush
- Combs

Valuables

The hospital cannot be responsible for any of your valuables. These include rings, watches, radios, dentures, eye glasses/contacts, valuable papers, musical instruments, personal computers, photo identification, credit cards, etc. We ask that you send these items home with your family. You may keep such items in the belongings bin and safe located at the nurses station. Medications and large amounts of money are not to be kept on the unit. We encourage you to keep no more than five dollars at a time. Larger amounts of money should be sent home. Valuables unable to be sent home will be secured until discharge.
